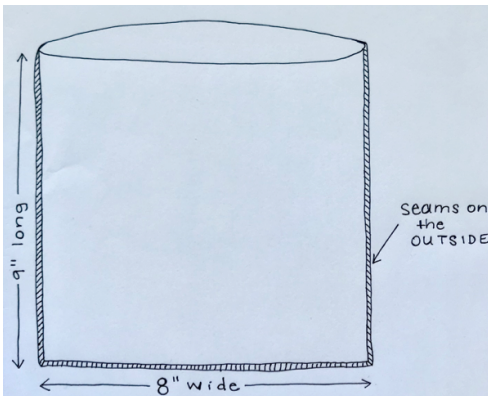




# HOW TO MAKE A FLYING SQUIRREL POUCH



1. **Select a polar fleece or flannel fabric.** (*Knitted or crocheted materials are unsafe for wildlife as their claws can easily snag in the material and cause injury!*)
2. **Cut either two pieces of fabric 8" wide and 9" long OR 1 piece of fabric 8" wide and 18" long.**
3. **Sew together all open sides EXCEPT for the top and keep the seams on the outside (to keep fingers and toes safe!).** (*If sewing by hand, make sure your stitching is very tight so there are no holes where babies might get caught!*)
4. **Send your pouch to P.O. Box 824, Candler, NC 28715!**
